## **Buffalo Bills Afghan**

Size: 40" x 48" (180 st by 300 rows)

## Materials:

less than <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> skein of Reynolds Utopia 200 White less than <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> skein of Reynolds Utopia 236 Red 9 skeins Reynolds Utopia 008 Blue Size 8 circular needle 40" yarn needle

## Gauge:

16 st x 25 rows = 4" x 4"

With blue, cast on 180 sts. Work 12 rows in K1, P1 seed stitch.

Row 13: Work the first 9 sts in seed stitch as established, k 162 st, work the last 9 sts in seed stitch as established.

Row 14: Work the first 9 sts in seed stitch as established, p 162 st, work the last 9 sts in seed stitch as established.

Continue in st st for another 58 rows. (Total rows completed will be 72.)

As you continue knitting, the border will be in seed stitch and the body of the afghan, including the logo and lettering will be in st st.

Knit the logo from the chart. It is 82 rows. The black on the chart should be knit using White.


After the logo is complete, work 25 rows of st st with Blue keeping the border in seed st. Follow the chart and continue for the next 48 rows. (There are 8 rows of st st between the lettering.)

Work 61 rows of st st, keeping the border in seed st. Work 12 rows or seed st. Bind off.
