# Aran Toilet Roll Cover Sue

yarn needle

## **Materials**:

1 skeins of Cascade 220, 100% Peruvian
Highland Wool, color 9463B
US size 8 (5mm) straight needles or the size to
obtain width of cover
US size 7 (4.5mm) straight needles
cable needle (cn)
8 stitch markers (safety-pin type)



Fits toilet roll with a 17" circumference and height of 4"

Gauge: Not critical. Finished width of ½ the body of the sweater about 7"

#### Notes:

- The first and last stitches are selvedge stitches and are knitted on the right side and purled on the wrong side.
- Smaller needles are used for neck and sleeve ribbing only.

## **Abbreviations**

B/O	Bind off	P	Purl

## **Body** (make 2)

With larger needles, cast on 37 sts.

Row 1 (rs): K1, p1 across row ending with k1.

Rows 2 - 5: Continue in 1x1 ribbing.

Row 6 (increase row): Continue in ribbing as established, work 4 sts, (M1, work 5) 5 times, (M1, work 4 sts) twice. (44 sts)

Row 7: K1, work Row 1 of chart, K1.

Row 8: P1, work Row 2 of chart, P1.

Work the chart 4 times (working the first and last sts in stockinette stitch). Mark the beginning and end of the row for sleeve placement.

Work the chart 4 more times (working the first and last sts in stockinette stitch). Mark the beginning and end of the row for end of back and front placement.

## Shape neck

Row 1: K1, p2tog, (k1, p1) twice, p3tog, k4, p2tog, k12, p2tog, k4, p3tog, (k1, p1) twice, k2tog, k1. (36 sts)

Row 2: Work across row in pattern as established.

Row 3: K1, k2tog, p1, k1, p2, work in pattern as established to the last 7 sts, (p1, k1) twice, p2tog, k1. (34 sts)

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

Row 5: K2, p1, k1, p2, s1 kwise, k2tog, psso, k1, p14, k1, k3tog, (p1, k1) 3 times. (30 sts)

Row 6: P2, (k1, p1) twice, work in pattern over 14 sts, (k1, p1) 4 times.

Row 7: K1, (k1, p1) 3 times, k1, work in pattern over 14 sts, (p1, k1) 4 times.

Row 8: Repeat Row 2.

Row 9: K1, p2tog, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2tog, (k1, p1) 5 times, k2 tog, (p1, k1) twice, p1, k2tog, k1. (26 sts)

## Change to smaller needles:

Row 10: P2, (k1, p1) to end of row.

Continue in ribbing for 12 more rows, keeping the first and last stitch in stockinette.

B/O in pattern.

Using the mattress stitch, seam the two pieces together from beginning of the neck edge to the top of the neck.

### Sleeve 1

Beginning at the first marker, pick up and knit 16 sts on one side to beginning of seam; pick up and knit 16 sts down the other side to marker.

Row 1 (ws): P1, (k1, p1) 5 times, k3, p4, k2, (p1, k1) 5 times, p2.

Row 2: K1, (p1, k1) 6 times, p3, C4F (see Key to Chart), p2, (k1, p1) 5 times, k2.

Row 3: P1, (k1, p1) 5 times, k3, p4, k2, (p1, k1) 5 times, p2.

Row 4: (K1, p1) 6 times, p2, k4, p2, (k1, p1) 5 times, k2.

Repeat rows 1 - 4 five times.

Repeat rows 1–3 once.

Decrease row: P1, p2tog, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1, k2tog, p1, p2tog, p1, ssk, (p1, k1) 4 times, p1, k2tog, p1. (27 sts)

Change to smaller needles.

Next row: \*K1, p1 to end of row, ending with K1.

Work 3 rows of 1x1 rib as established.

B/O in pattern.


#### Sleeve 2

Work as for sleeve 1 replacing C4F with C4B.

## **Finishing**

Sew remaining side and sleeve seams. Fold neckband to the inside and tack down. Weave in all ends.

# **Key to Chart**



Knit on the right side; purl on the wrong side.

Purl on the right side; knit on the wrong side.

C4B: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, k2 from cable needle.

C4F: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, k2 from cable needle.

K1, p1, k1 into the stitch.

P3 together.
