

Wine Bottle Cover

Fits 1.5 liter bottle

Materials:

Worsted Weight, MC of your choice (about 1¼ oz.), green for leaves and purple for grapes.
Size 8 double pointed needles
H crochet hook

Gauge: 14 sts = 3" in st st.

Cable: Place 3 sts on cable needle and hold in front of work. Knit next 3 sts, knit the 3 sts from the cable needle.

Cast on 4 sts.

Rnd 1: Increase 1 st in each st around (8 sts)

Rnd 2 and all even rounds: Knit.

Rnd 3: *Increase 1 st in next st, K1, * repeat between *s around. (16 st)

Rnd 5: *K2, M1 repeat from around. (24 st)

Repeat rounds 2 and 5 increasing 8 sts every other round until 56 sts.

Rnd 13: Purl

Rnds 14–18: *P2, K6*, repeat between *s around

Rnd 19: *P2, Cable*, repeat between *s around.

Rnds 20–25: Repeat rounds 14–19 twice.

Rnds 26–27: Repeat round 14.

Rnd 28: Knit.

Knit around until pieces measures 9½" from purl row.

Repeat rounds 14–19 once.

Repeat round 14 three times.

Next round: *YO, p2tog, K6,* repeat between *s around.

Next rnd: Repeat round 14 once.

Next round: Repeat rnd 19.

Repeat round 14 three times.

Bind off using sewn bind off.

Leaf (Make 6 or 7)

Cast on 3 sts, leaving a tail to sew on leaf.

Row 1: K1, yo, K1, yo, K1.

Row 2 and all even rows: Purl

Row 3: K2, yo, K1, yo, K2. (7 sts)

Row 5: K3, yo, K1, yo, K3. (9 sts)

Row 7: K4, yo, K1, yo, K4. (11 sts)

Row 9: SSK, K7, K2 tog. (9 sts)

Row 11: SSK, K5, K2 tog. (7 sts)



Row 13: SSK, K3, K2 tog. (5 sts)

Row 15: SSK, K1, K2 tog. (3 sts)

Row 17: S1, K2 tog, PSSO

Cut yarn leaving a tail to sew on leaf.

Grapes (Make 7 or 8):

Cast on 1 sts.

Row 1: ([K1 f & b]) twice, K1) all in same st. (5 st)

Rows 2 – 6: Starting with a Purl row, work in st st.

Row 7: SSK, K1, K2 tog. (3 st)

Row 8: P3 tog.

End, leaving a tail about 12". Weave yarn around outer stitches, pull up to make a bobble.

Tie:

Crochet a chain about 14" long. Single crochet in each chain across. End. Work ends in.

With the wrong sides of two leaves facing, whip stitch the leaves together. Sew to the end of the tie. Make a cluster of grapes with 3 or 4 of the bobbles and fasten to the other end of the tie.

Sew leaves and grapes on wine cover.
