

# Rich's Golf Club Covers

## Materials (for three covers)

Berroco Vintage, 52% Acrylic, 40% Wool, 8% Nylon, 3.5 oz/100 g,  
218 yds/200 m

2 skeins Color 5145, Cast Iron

1 skein Color 5101, Mochi (for numbers and pompoms)

US size 7 (4.5 mm) double pointed needles

US size 8 (5 mm) double pointed needles

3 flexible foam discs, 1½" round, ⅜" thick, with two small holes

(I made these cut from a ⅜" thick foam door hanger.)

Yarn needle

Finished Size: approximately 5" x 14"

Gauge: 19 sts = 4"/10 cm in stockinette stitch with larger needles. Take the time to check your gauge!

Note: 1 skein will make 1 cover; 2 skeins will make 3 covers.

## Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl
PSSO	Pass slipped stitch over the 2 knitted stitches
Rep	Repeat
YO	Yarn over

## Directions:

Cast on 50 sts. Join, being careful not to twist stitches.

Rnds 1 and 2: \*P2, k3; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: \*P2, sl1 purlwise, k2, pssso; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: \*P2, k1, yo, k1; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Rep Rnds 1 – 4 for 9" (17 repeats of Rnds 1 – 4).

Rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Change to larger needles.

Work in stockinette stitch for piece measures 4" (approximately 27 rows).

Duplicate stitch the desired number.

## Shape top:

Rnd 1: \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (40 sts)

Rnd 2: K.

Rnd 3: \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30 sts)

Rnd 4: K.

Rnd 5: \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (20 sts)



Foam Disc

Rnd 6: K.

Rnd 7: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (10 sts)

Rnd 8: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (5 sts)

Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail. Thread through remaining 5 sts twice and pull tight. Weave end into inside of cover.

Make two pompoms leaving two 8" tails.

Thread the two tails separately to inside of cover. Each tail should be on opposite sides of center. Thread the same two tails through the holes in the discs. Pull tight and tie into a knot. Trim these tails to about 2".
