Mason Jar Cozy

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I designed this cozy to use with the mason jars containing the wonderful products from webejammin.

Materials

Worsted weight yarn, sample in Cascade 220, 100% Peruvian Highland Wool

Size 6 (4 mm) double pointed needles

Yarn needle

Gauge: 22 sts = 4" in flat stockinette stitch, unblocked. Gauge is not critical; this cozy is very stretchy.

Abbreviations

CCD Center Double Decrease: Slip 2 together knitwise,

k1, pass the two slipped stitches over the knitted

stitch at the same time.

 $egin{array}{ll} K & Knit. \\ P & Purl. \\ Rnd(s) & Round(s). \end{array}$

SSK Slip 1 as to knit, slip 1 as to purl. Return both

stitches to the left needle and knit together.

St(s) Stitch(es) Tog Together.



Directions

Cast on 40 sts, join in the round being careful not to twist the stitches K2P2 ribbing for 5 rnds.

Each needle should have 10 sts.

Rnd 1: (P3, ssk, yo, k3, yo, k2tog) 4x.

Rnds 2 and 4: (P2, k7) 4x.

Rnd 3: (P3, k2, yo, CDD, yo, k2,) 4x.

Repeat these 4 rows for 5" (includes the ribbing).

Next 2 rnds: K.

Bottom:

Rnd 1: *K2tog, k3* around.

Rnd 2: *K2tog, k2* around.

Rnd 3: *K2tog, k1* around.

Rnd 4: K2tog around.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Pull tail through remaining sts. Weave in ends.
