## **Mini Prayer Cloth**

One or Two Colors

I knitted this for a friend who was very stressed over the last week. She is one of the most spiritual people I know and she has a great in abiding faith in Christ. I hope this will help her a little bit in those stressful moments.

Samples were knitted in Cascade 220 on US7 needles. Any yarn and needle size may be used.

## Abbreviations:

CC Contrasting Color

K Knit

MC Main Color

P Purl

RS: Right Side

WS Wrong Side

## **One-Color Cloth**

Cast on 17 sts. This is the bottom of the cloth.

Rows 1 - 4: K.

Row 5 (RS): K2, p13, k2.

Row 6 and all even rows through Row 28.: k.

Rows 7, 9, 11, 13, 15: K2, p5, k3, p5, k2.

Rows 17, 19 and 21: K2, p2, k9, p2, k2.

Rows 23 and 25: Repeat Row 7.

Row 27: Repeat Row 5.

Rows 29 – 31: K.

Bind off knitwise.

Weave in ends. Block.

## **Two-Color Cloth** (Intarsia)

Note: Do not carry the MC across the CC.

Use a separate ball of yarn.

Be sure to twist the yarns when changing

color.

Unless stated, you will be knitting with the MC.

With MC, cast on 17 sts.

Rows 1 - 4: K.

Row 5 (WS): K2, p13, k2.

Row 6: K7, CC k3, k7.

Row 7: K2, p5, CC k3, p5, k2.

Rows 8, 10, 12, 14, 16: K7, CC k3, k7.

Rows 9, 11,13, 15, 17: K2, p5, CC k3, p5, k2.

Row 18: K4, CC k9, k4.

Row 19: K2, p2, CC k9, p2, k2.

Row 20: K4, CC k9, k4.

Row 21: K2, p2, CC k9, p2, k2.

Row 22: K4, CC k9, k4.

Row 23: K2, p2, CC k9, p2, k2.

Row 24: K7, CC k3, k7.

Row 25: K2, p5, CC k3, p5, k2.

Row 26: Repeat Row 24.

Row 27: K2, p13, k2.

Row 28: K.

Row 29: K2, p13, k2.

Rows 30 - 33: K.

Bind off knitwise.

Weave in ends. Block.
