

Mock Cable Mason Jar Cozy

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I designed this cozy (second of two) to use with the mason jars containing the wonderful products from [webejammin](http://webejammin.com). For taller jars, increase the number of rounds.

Materials

Worsted weight yarn, sample in Cascade 220, 100%
Peruvian Highland Wool (enough for
approximately 10 cozies)
Size 6 (4 mm) double pointed needles
Yarn needle

Gauge: 22 sts = 4" in flat stockinette stitch, unblocked.
Gauge is not critical; this cozy is very stretchy.

Abbreviations

K	Knit.
P	Purl.
PSSO	Knit 2, pass slipped st over 2 sts just knit.
Rnd(s)	Round(s).
S1 purlwise	Slip 1 st purlwise.
St(s)	Stitch(es)
y/o	Yarn over

Directions

Cast on 48 sts, 12 sts on each needle; join in the round
being careful not to twist the stitches
K2P2 ribbing for 5 rnds.

Rnd 1: (K3, p1) around.

Rnd 2: (S1 pwise, k2, pssso, p1) around.

Rnd 3: (K1, y/o, k1, p1) around.

Rnd 4: (K3, p1) around.

Repeat these 4 rows ending with Rnd 4 for 5" (includes the ribbing).

Next 2 rnds: K.

Bottom:

Rnd 1: (K2tog, k4) around.

Rnd 2: (K2tog, k3) around.

Rnd 3: (K2tog, k2) around.

Rnd 4: (K2tog, k1) around.

Rnd 5: (K2tog) around. (8 sts)

Cut yarn, leaving an 8" tail. Pull tail through remaining sts. Weave in ends.
